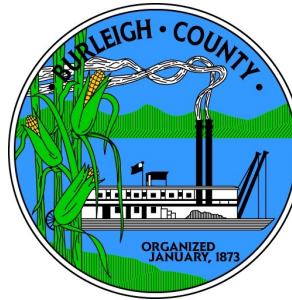

## Be A Poll Worker

Want to get paid to do a good thing? You can **earn \$15 per hour as a poll worker** — and the experience will look great on your resume or college application.

Being a poll worker means you are serving your community — experience that can make you **more attractive to future employers** and college and university admissions boards.

Being a poll worker is a **fun** opportunity to meet new people and help your friends and neighbors. Besides, your **community needs** more people like you to work at the polls. North Dakota must recruit and train thousands of poll workers in communities across the state every election year.

Your local election officials will teach you everything you need to know to do the job. You just need to meet a **few requirements** to be selected:

- You must be a U.S. citizen
- You should be at least 16 years old
- You should be a resident of North Dakota and Burleigh County

**Earn money doing a good thing.**

**It's as easy as 1-2-3.**

- 1.** First, you'll attend a short training class to learn how to be a poll worker. Then, you're ready to go to work.
- 2.** On Election Day you'll help set up the polling place before your friends and neighbors arrive to vote.
- 3.** Finally, you'll check voters in at the polling place and explain how they cast their ballots. Once the day is done, you and your fellow poll workers will close the polling place.
