



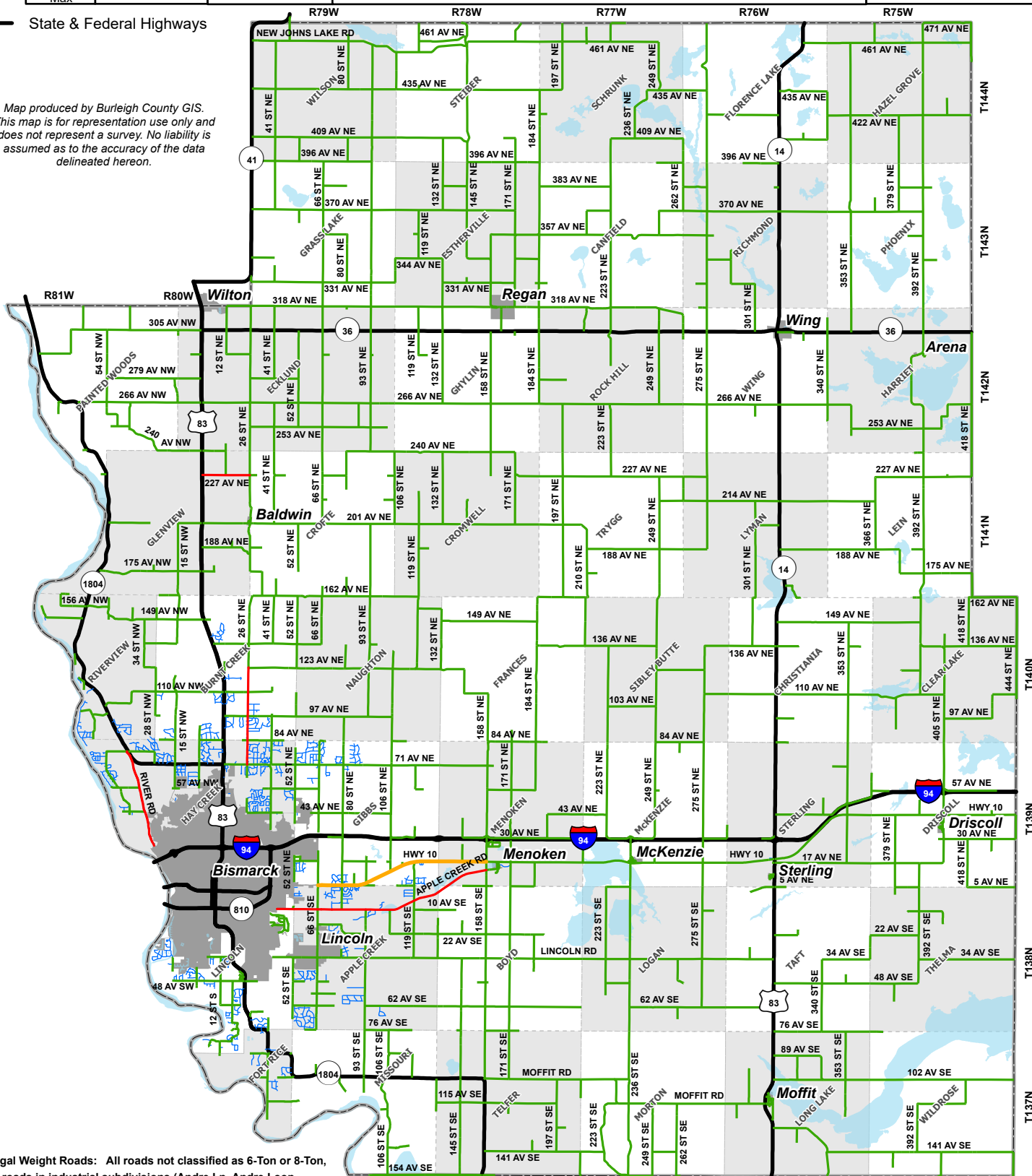

6-Ton Roads: River Rd (from Ward Rd, north to State Hwy 1804), 26th St NE (from 71st Ave, north to 123rd Ave), Apple Creek Rd (from Yegen Rd, east to 158th St), 227th Ave NE (from US Hwy 83, east to 26th St)

80,000 Lbs Max Roads: Hwy 10 (from 66th St NE, east to 158th St NE)
